NATIONAL OPIOID SETTLEMENT BACKGROUND

Ten defendant companies have executed national opioid settlements totaling more than \$46 billion. Under the OneOhio Memorandum of Understanding, Ohio has opted-in to all of these national settlements. While not all settlements are finalized, and future opioid litigation is possible, the chart below provides an overview of all current national settlements in process and their anticipated funding impact on Ohio and the OneOhio Recovery Foundation.
